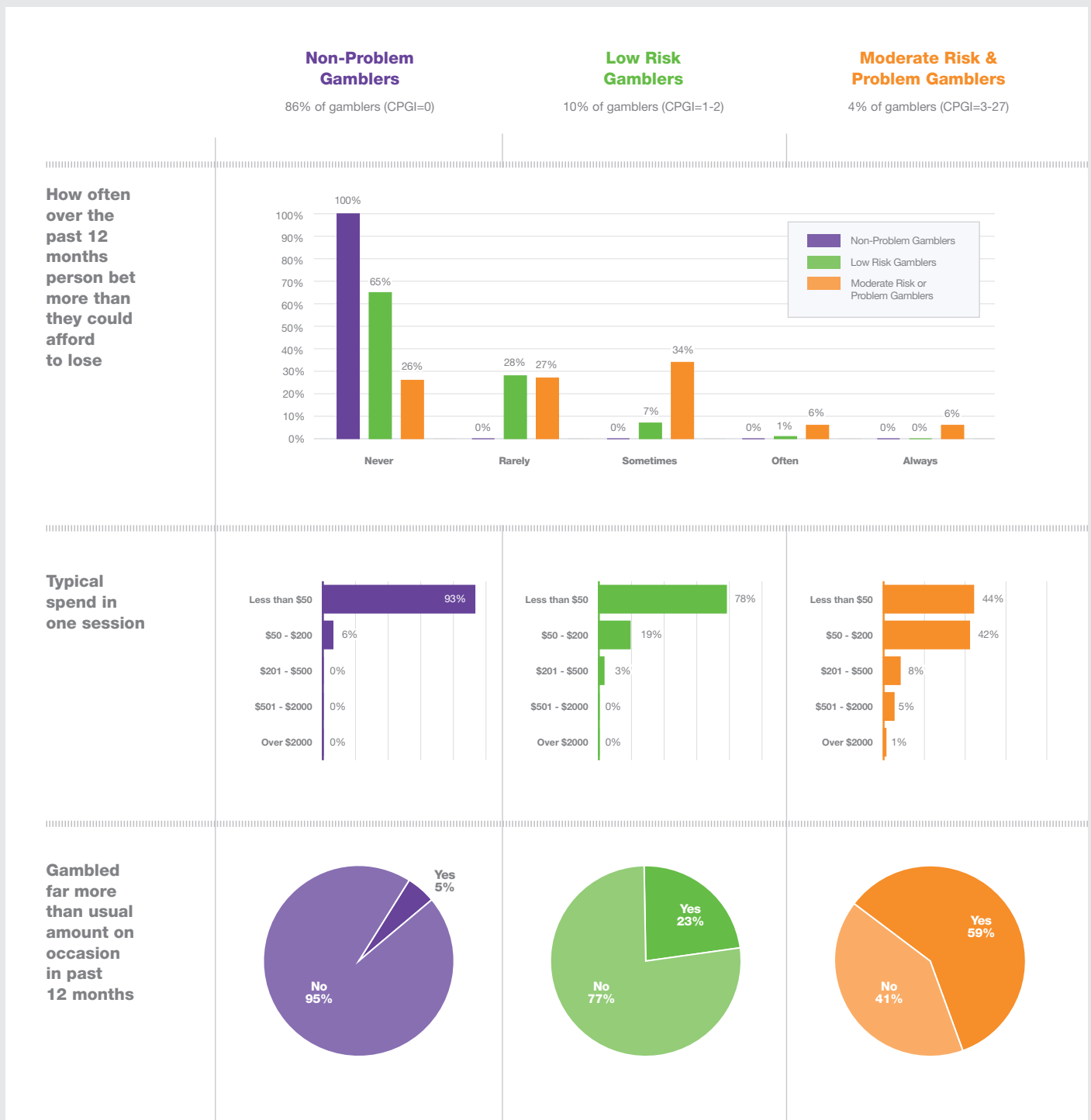




The 2012 survey of Gambling Prevalence in South Australia was conducted during the period October to December 2012. It sought to describe the gambling patterns of adults and young people in South Australia and involved 9,508 telephone interviews.

The following tables present a side by side comparison of non-problem gamblers, low risk gamblers and moderate and problem gamblers in terms of gambling behaviours.





Non-Problem Gamblers

86% of gamblers (CPGI=0)

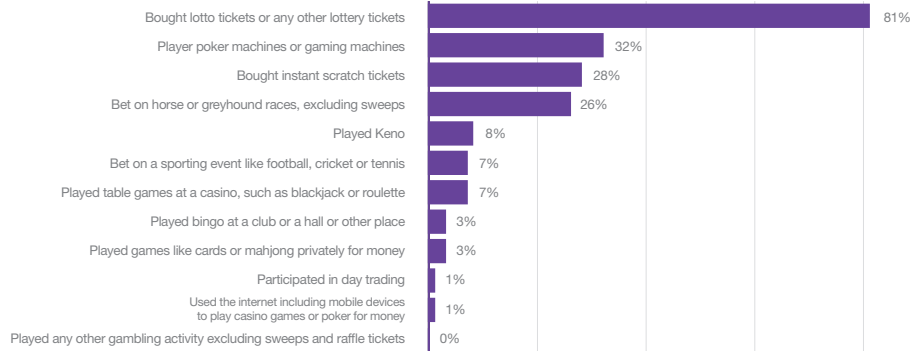
Low Risk Gamblers

10% of gamblers (CPGI=1-2)

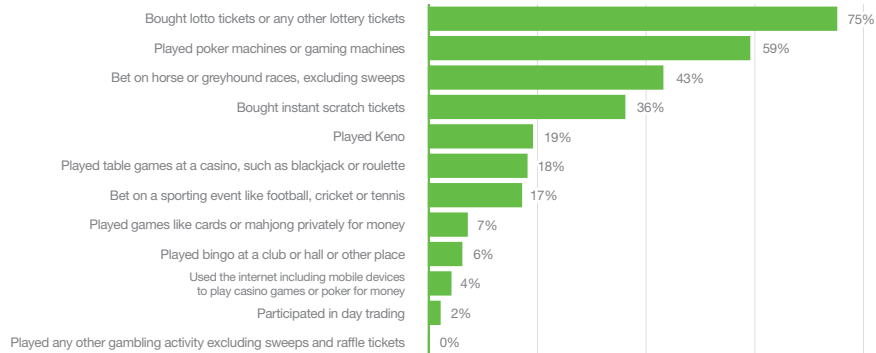
Moderate Risk & Problem Gamblers

4% of gamblers (CPGI=3-27)
